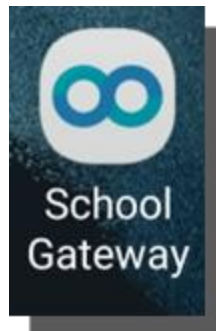

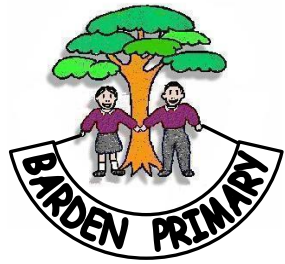

What has your child been learning about in class this week?

Cygnets

We have had a great week in Cygnets! We have been exploring Pirate's Love Underpants in Maths and English as 'p-p-p pirate' has been our sound of the week for Phonics. In Maths we have explored matching and pattern and we even made our own pirate ship! We have also been focussing on Makaton and learning how to sign 'hello my name is...'. Well done Cygnets!



R- Eaglets

Another great week in Eaglets! In Magic Maths, we have been learning to add different amounts together. In Literacy, we have been reading the story 'Pirates love underpants' and writing sentences about the pirates following a map to get to the treasure! In Art, we have been looking at an artist called Maggi Hambling. We were inspired by Maggi and created our very own seashells out of clay. Well done Eaglets!



1- Robins

Another busy week in Robins. We have been continuing with our work all about trains in English our lessons. We are fast becoming train experts! We really enjoyed our time with the artist in school and have been working hard to create our own masterpieces using primary and secondary colours using tint and shade. Well done Robins!



2- Swallows

Swallows have tried very hard in maths this week. We have been learning to describe movements in our position and direction unit. In computing, we thought about all the ways our households use technology for their jobs. In English, we have persuaded people to come to Prince Ali's amazing carnival. We used some great adjectives and told people it was 'the best show in the whole world'!!! Well done, Swallows. Keep trying hard.



3- Doves

Doves have had a great Art week this week where we have explored some of the different pointillism techniques and had a go at showing them in our own pieces of art work based on George Seurat's painting. In English, we have been creating our own prologue for the poem, the Spider and the Fly. In Maths, we have been exploring different 2D and 3D shapes. Well done Doves!



4- Kingfishers

Another great week in Kingfishers this week. The children have enjoyed Art week and working with the artists we have had in school. They have also enjoyed designing and making Roman mosaic tiles for our display. Well done Kingfishers!



5- Jays

Jays have been enjoying being creative during art week this week. We sketched and painted landscapes of Pendle Hill using water colours. We looked at paintings by local artists Keith Melling, Paddy Campbell and David Pott to inspire us. In maths, we have finished our unit on negative numbers, ready to move onto converting units next week.



6- Kestrels

We have had a great week in school working with Edward Foster the artist, we have sketched some fantastic creative pictures. We have also designed and made clay Viking jewellery and the children had a go at making some wire bracelets using Viking styles. We have started thinking about our future careers and dream jobs, the children have been busy writing their own CV's and thinking about their own skills and qualities. We had a fun afternoon with some games of rounders and cricket.
