R- Eaglets

What a great start to Spring 2! Eaglets have made a great start exploring our new topic Amazing Animals. This week we looked at pet animals and which animals make a good pet. In Magic Maths, we have been practising forming the number 9 and showing the number 9 in different ways. In Literacy, we have started our learning on the story I'm thinking of a PET.



Wrens 1

Year 1 have started this term with an exciting trip to our woodlands. The children became explorers to see what they could find as part of our roots, shoots and juicy fruits topic! They have also looked at a variety of seeds and bulbs and even planted their very own seeds. We will keep an eye on these to see how they grow and change each week.



2- Swallows

A great start to this half term, Swallows. We have developed our multiplication and division skills and looked at odd and even numbers. In English, we are starting our learning on the story Mudpuddle Farm. Our new topic is Animal Antics. We had our WOW! lesson and painted animals. We also showed our final DT projects to Mrs Holgate. She was so impressed with you!

Doves have made a great start this half term exploring our new topic The Groovy Greeks. We have become Ancient Greek investigators discovering new vocabulary in English and finding out about some of key historical figures and places in our history lessons. In Science, we have been discovering the names of the bones in our bodies. Well done Doves, an amazing start!



4- Kingfishers

What a start to spring 2! Kingfishers have been working hard finishing off our perimeter of shape work in Maths, and we are excited to start our new topic of fractions! In English, we have started reading our new class novel – The Firework Maker's Daughter by Philip Pullman with our grammar focus being similes and expanded noun phrases. We have also been practicing our times tables!



5- Jays

This week Jays have had an exciting first week back learning about space. On Monday we discovered an unidentifiable object in our playground, we think we might have had some visitors from outer space! 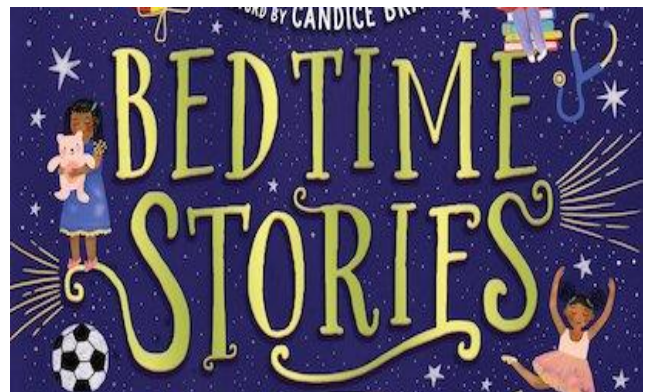
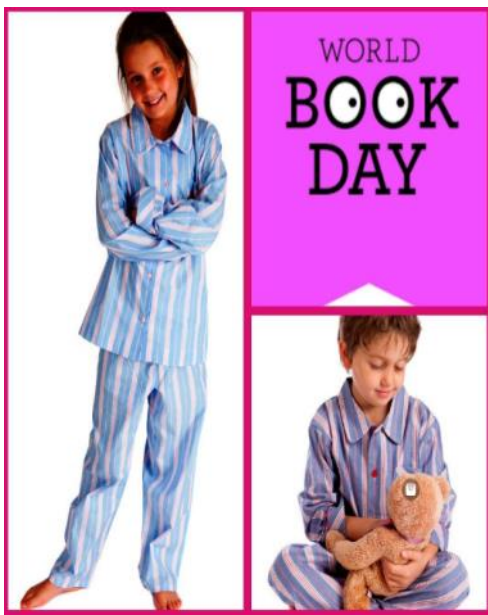
6- Kestrels



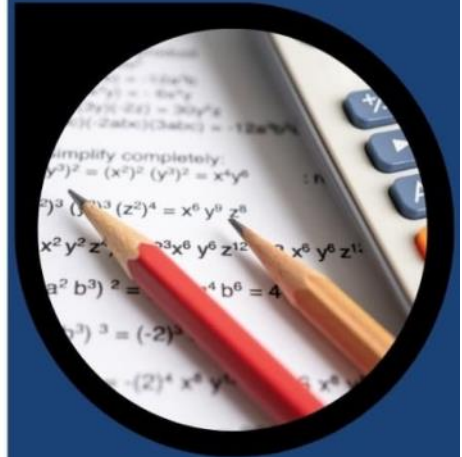
