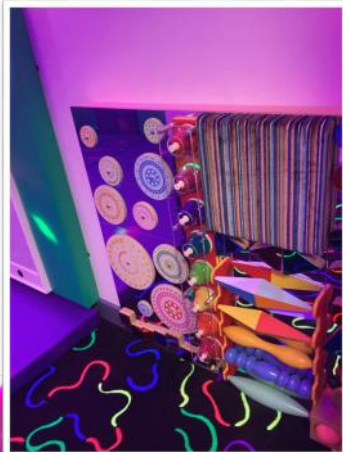
Go-Noodle!

R- Owlets

We have been talking about different kinds of magic especially about Christmas magic. We have begun to make Christmas cards and Christmas decorations ready to decorate the classroom in December. We have been making shapes with matchsticks and talking about their properties. Next week we might find something exciting in the woodland area!



1- Sparrows

We have had another great week in the Sparrows class. The children have been applying themselves well in English using Supertato to generate great writing. For Christmas Art Week, the children have been creating art for our country – France. We created artwork based on famous French features, such as the Eiffel Tower and famous French traditions during Christmas.
