# Curriculum

## What has your child been learning about in class this week?

If your child's class isn't in the newsletter this week, they will be next week.



R- Eaglets

This week in Eaglets we have been learning about the story of 'Room on the Broom.' We created a story map and added actions to it, we rode around the yard on our broomsticks.

In Magic Maths we have been looking at flat shapes, talking about their properties and naming the shapes. It has been a fun learning week.



Wrens 1

Year One have had a great week. We have started to get stuck in to our Supertato book which is our novel for this half term. The children made their very own Supertatos which was lots of fun! We have learnt all about Guy Fawkes and bonfire night and created some fantastic art using lots of exciting colours.



2- Swallows

A wonderful week, Swallows. We have started our linking project and met the teacher from our link school virtually! We have written a retell of the story Jack and the Beanstalk and used the word when to join. In maths, we continue on with our subtraction journey. Lots of base ten is helping us. Well done everyone!



3- Doves

Doves have worked hard this week learning about our new topic, Let's be Archeologists. We had our wow afternoon where we investigated different archeological finds, created Stonehenge and made our own cave art. In Geography, we explored Castercliff hill fort on google maps and have learnt about the purpose of different rocks in Science.



4- Kingfishers

Kingfishers have been working really hard this week continuing our exploration of our new text Rumaysa, learning all about precise nouns and creating character profiles. We have been learning multiplication and division facts on our 3-, 6- and 9-times tables in maths and have loved our PSHE lessons celebrating the things that make us different.



5- Jays

This week in Jays we have been working very hard. We made powerpoints in English about Fagin from Oliver Twist and have just finished our multiplication and division topic in maths. We started our new maths unit – fractions. In learning challenge we continued learning about the Anglo Saxons. We've learnt about the 7 Anglo Saxon Kingdoms in Britain and the pagan gods.



6- Kestrels

This week, we have been ordering and comparing fractions with different denominators in our Maths lessons. Walt Disney has been the focus of our English lessons; we have been gathering information and key dates from different sources in preparation for writing our own biography. In our learning challenge lessons, we have been looking at evacuation and the impact it had on the lives of children during WWII. We also completed a piece of art work, linked to Remembrance Day, to display in our corridor area.
