What has your child been learning about in class this week?

If your child's class isn't in the newsletter this week, they will be next week.



R- Owlets

It is Magical School for two weeks. Magical powers have taken over the classroom and we have pumpkins, cauldrons, a magic shop, spiders and lots more! We have been on an adventure across the wobbly green jelly to the enchanted wood where we found sticks to make into magic wands. We are reading the book 'Room on the Broom' by Julia Donaldson and having lots of fun acting out the story.



1- Robins

Robins have made a brilliant start to this half term. We started our new topic, 'Let's Celebrate' by having a party to celebrate being in year one and all the hard work we have achieved so far. We had an exciting time. In English we have been looking at different fruits and vegetables, describing how they look and taste. The children have been using some wonderful adjectives. Well done, Robins.



2- Wagtails

Wagtails have had a fantastic start to this half term! We have started our new topic – Aussie Adventure – and had lots of fun painting Australian animals, playing a big Australian themed board games and learning about continents and oceans! We have started our subtraction in maths and also our new topic of Traditional Tales in English! Lots of fantastic work this week, well done Wagtails!



3- Skylarks

Skylarks have had a great first week back! This week we have started our new topic 'Let's be archeologists' and we are really enjoying finding out all about what life was like in the Stone Age. We have worked really hard in guided reading and have made fantastic predictions about our new class novel 'The Day I Fell into a Fairy Tale.' We are continuing our work on adding and subtracting in maths and we have just started looking at Folk Tales in English. Well done, Skylarks!



4- Woodpeckers

Welcome back Woodpeckers! This week we have started new topics in all subjects. In Maths, we have begun to look at Multiplication and Division. In English, we have started our Fairy Tales unit, based on the book Rumaysa. In our Learning Challenge lessons, our new topic is 'A Bit of Sparkle' and we started the unit with an incredibly cool lesson including five different experiments based on static electricity.



5- Puffins

Puffins have made a great start to this half term. We have started to read Oliver, which is our new text in English. The children have explored new vocabulary and learnt about what life was like in the Victorian times. We are looking forward to exploring the story further next week. We also created some remembrance art work. The children experimented with water colours and layering.



6- Eagles

Eagles have had a great first week back in school! We have started reading 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas' as our class novel. This is part of our WW2 topic where we would experience life as an evacuee. The teachers have decorated the year 6 building as what life would have been like during 19. In Maths, we have started our new unit on fractions, this is tricky but we are persevering!
