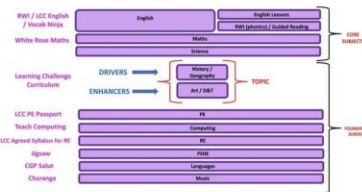

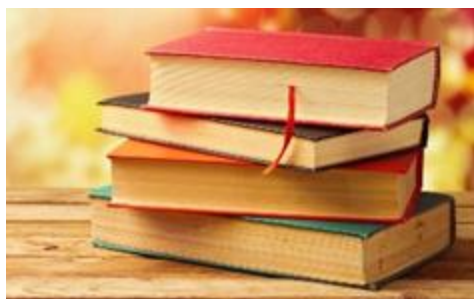

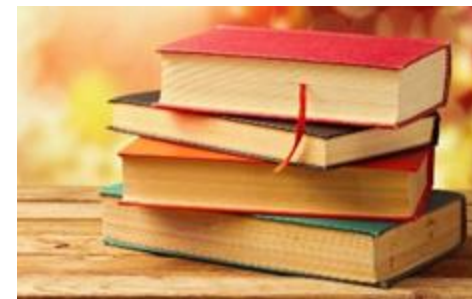

Swans

We have had another great week in Swans class this week. We have moved on from number and are now looking at addition and subtraction. Our Science work has turned a corner too and we have been looking at animals and their young, including how the diets vary from animal to animal. We have continued our 3D sculpture work in art and can't wait to display the work in our entrance.



R- Owlets

We have been learning about refuse collectors - how they help us and recycle rubbish. We have looked at the work of artist Andy Goldsworthy. We collected natural materials from the woodland area and created pictures inspired by his work. We have been looking at pattern in Magic Maths, spotting them around school and creating our own patterns with objects and actions. Well done Owlets



1- Robins

Another great week in Robins. In English we have become mice experts. We have been asking each other lots of questions about mice and working hard to find the answers. In Maths we have been using part-whole models to help us with our addition, In art we have been using different art pencils to draw self-portraits. Well done Robins.



2- Swallows

What a wonderful week, Swallows. You have tried super hard in maths ordering and comparing numbers and investigating past tense verbs in English. Some great ideas for how can stay safe when using technology-have you shared your ideas at home? Well done too for your amazing assembly performance you truly are a super KIND class! Well done.



3- Skylarks

We have had a brilliant week in Skylarks class! We have been working really hard in English, gathering lots of information for our non chronological reports about London. We have also done a fantastic job in science, conducting our own experiments to find out about human skeletons. Our DT interactive London posters are looking fantastic too. Well done Skylarks!

We have had a great week in year 4. The children have made a start on their canopic jar sculptures by using paper mache. We have also looked at who Tutankhamun was.
