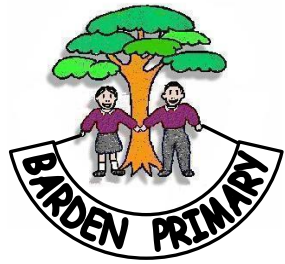

Cygnets

We have had a great week! We have been continuing our work about understanding emotions. This week we have focussed on sadness, and we created our own colour monsters. The children also explored that it is okay to feel sad and we looked at what we can do when we feel sad to help us feel better. We also enjoyed watching Barden's Got Talent on Monday!



R- Eaglets

What a brilliant week we have had. In Literacy, we finished reading the story 'Pirates love underpants' and ended the unit creating our story maps. In Magic Maths, we have been adding two numbers together to make 10. We have visited our year one class ready for September – we will be with Mrs Stansfield and Mrs Greenwood.



1- Robins

It has been another great week! In Maths we have started our learning on Time, the children are trying really hard to master telling the time. In English we have been watching and writing a Thomas the Tank Engine story. The children have produced some fabulous written work. In art we have been using Dan Mather for inspiration for our art work.



2- Wagtails

We have had a great week in Wagtails. On Monday we loved watching Barden's Got Talent! Our two acts did us proud! We have continued with our work in English based around Aladdin. We have focused on using different types of conjunction. We have loved art week! We have explored Monet's art work on the view of the thames and created our own pieces inspired by this. They look fantastic!



3- Doves

This week, we have begun our independent writing based on the poem "The Spider and The Fly". We have planned our stories using the original plot and changed aspects of it to make it our own! This week, we have also enjoyed art week where we have used our knowledge and skills from pointillism to create some beautiful pieces of artwork inspired by George Seurat!



4- Kingfishers

This week we have been learning how to write newspaper articles about a mischievous cat. In maths, Kingfishers are learning about different types of angles and triangles. Our artwork has had us learning about reflection and rotational symmetry and using this to create Roman mosaic designs. In addition, our art week activities have seen us produce great surrealist images.



5- Jays

Jays have been working hard this week. We have enjoyed art week this week, creating different pieces of art inspired by Africa. We created tribal masks, African patterns and African inspired animal art. We also loved watching Barden's Got Talent on Monday and well done to our entrants for their super performances!
