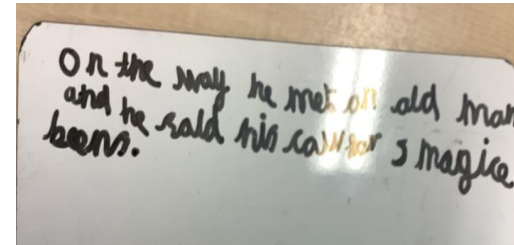

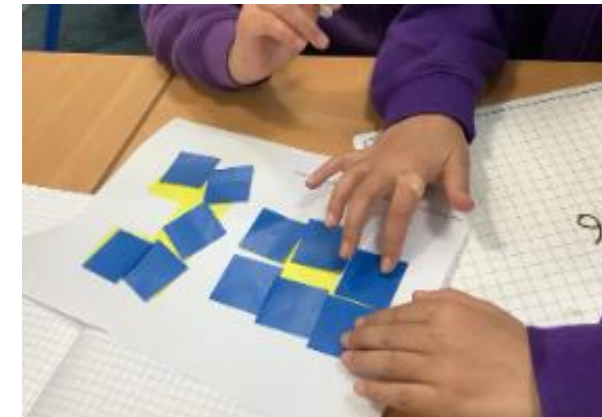
It was outdoor learning day this week. The children spent the morning outside, making firework pictures and toasting marshmallows!
