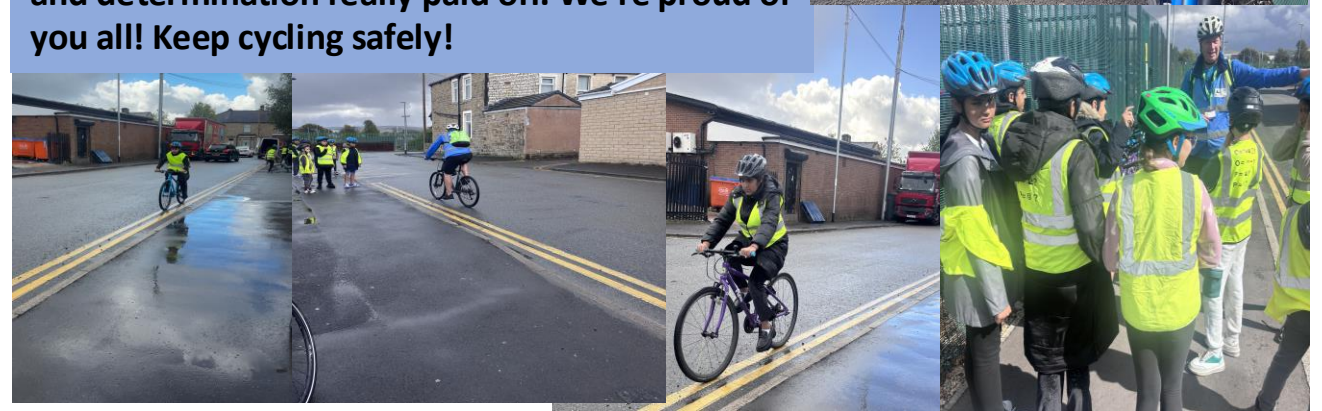

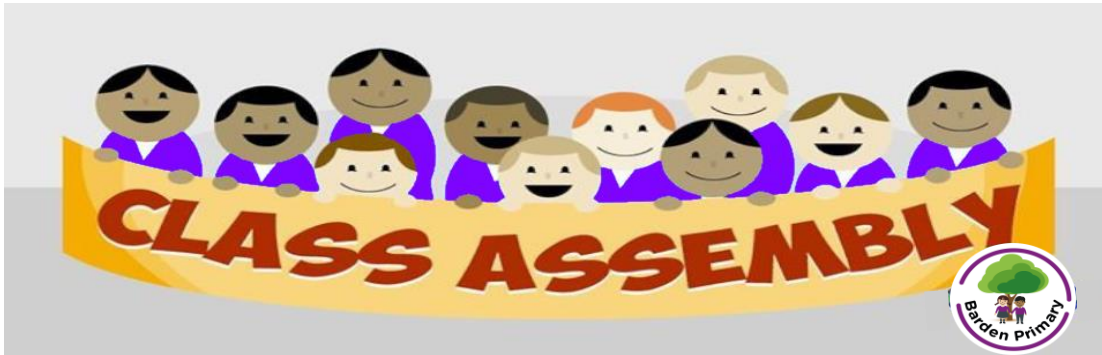


Test your children at home and see if they can tell you the name of the tallest mountain in the UK and the tallest mountain in the world, they should even be able to tell you how tall they are.
