## DT

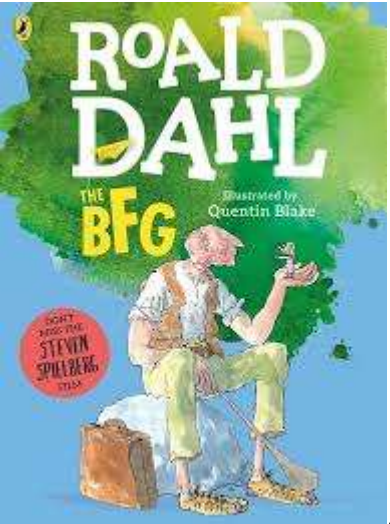
### Mechanisms

## Music

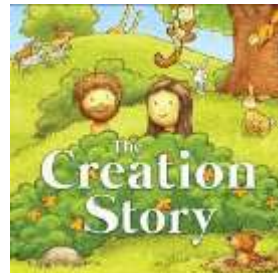
We are learning to play and sing together. We will develop our performance and present our song to an audience.
