Science Materials

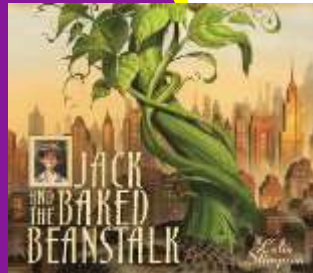
They will learn all about natural and man-made materials. Children will be able to describe different properties and say which materials are most suitable for certain uses.

In English we read the text: 'Jack and the Baked Beanstalk' and explore fairytales with a twist. We innovate our own stories using talk for writing and story maps.



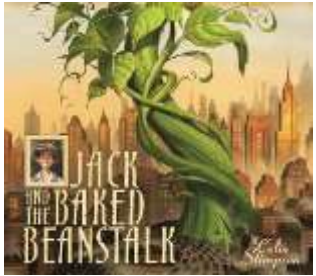
DT
