



# Year 3



## Maths

Addition and Subtraction of numbers up to 1000.

Multiplication and division.



## English

Children will continue to develop their narrative writing skills by planning, writing, and editing their own stories based on folk tales.

Children will begin to use subordinating conjunctions in their writing, as well as adverbs for how and expanded noun phrases.

## Science

This term, children will explore rocks, fossils, and soils. They will learn how to group and categorise rocks based on their properties. They will also learn about the formation of fossils and what soils are made from.



## History

Children will learn about the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. They will learn about how life, tools and homes changed over time.



## Art

In Art, children will learn all about ancient cave paintings, which is linked to our history topic "Savage Stone Age." Children will explore where cave paintings originated, including the tools, textures, lines and shapes used to create them.

## PE

Children will have the opportunity to explore movement through dance, inspired by superheroes. They will also learn how to use a one-handed pass and bounce pass in our invasion games unit.
