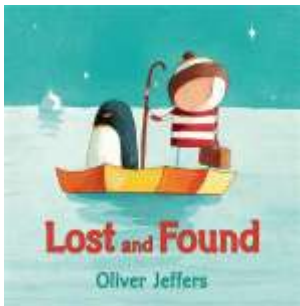
As part of our Hot and Cold places topic, we will be exploring different types of sculptures and using clay to make our own version of an igloo.
