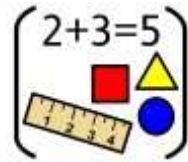




# Cygnets

### Life processes and living things -Plants

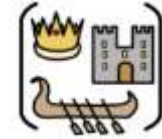
Pupils will learn about plants and what they need to grow. Children will be planting their own bean plant and learning how to look after it.

Pupils will explore the topic of Space with a focus on Neil Armstrong and the moon landing. Children will explore this through multi-sensory teaching.



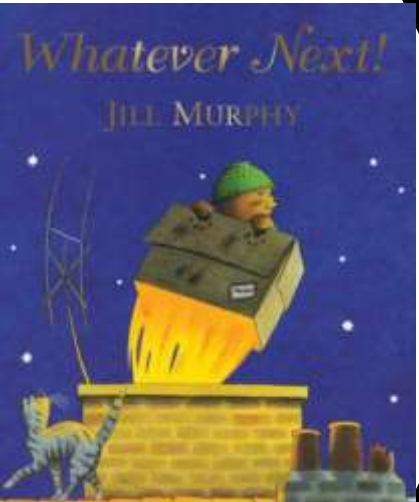
## Art Printing
