Maths

Addition and subtraction

Multiplication and division.



Science

The children will learn all about rocks and fossils.

They will be able to identify the properties of rocks. They will also gain an understanding of how soil and fossils are formed.

Geography

In this unit of work, the children will have the opportunity to explore the human and physical features of Lancashire and Tuscany. They will also develop their map reading skills and using 4-figure-grid references.

English

This half term, children will explore narrative skills through the Iron Man book, including descriptive techniques and using direct speech. They will cover grammar skills such as complex sentences and using inverted commas to support their writing.
