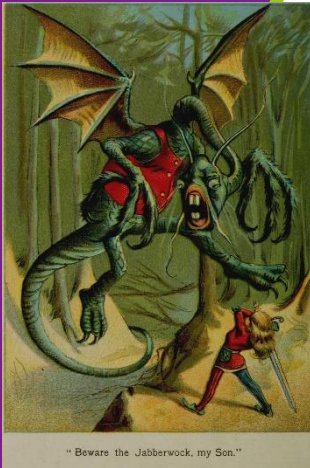




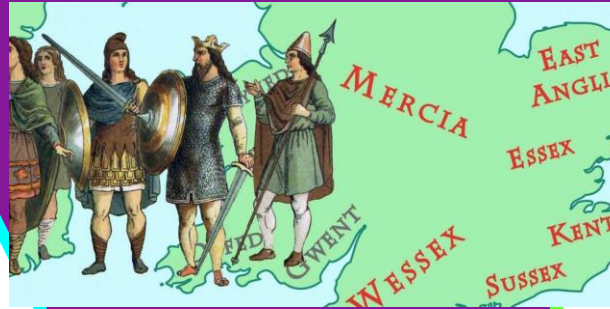
Year 5

Jabberwocky

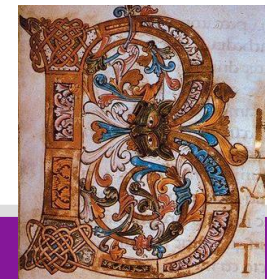
This half term the children will explore the poem the Jabberwocky. We will be innovating our own poem and writing a persuasive argument.

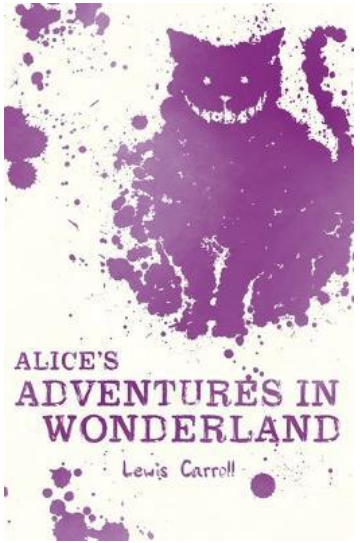
Art
