### 3D and mixed media.

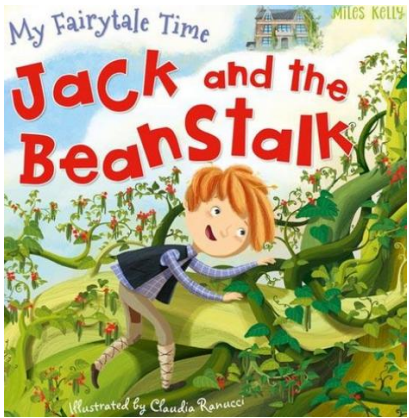
Pupils will explore creating 3D and mixed media artwork. We are aiming to create a large scale collage linked to our Science topic of plants.
