Read Write Inc -We will be continuing to learn sounds, including 'special friends' sounds. We will be reading Ditty books. Your child's RWInc teacher will explain to you the ways you need to support your child with reading the books at home. You can read books online with your child on Oxford Owl. We will be practising the sounds in games and other fun activities.

We will share lots of wonderful stories which will develop speaking and listening - continuing to look at how a story can be split into a beginning, middle and end.

We will encourage children to write their names, words, phrases and sentences. Focusing on using sounds to write words, leave finger spaces and remembering to start a sentence with a capital letter and end it with a full stop and remembering to form the letters correctly.

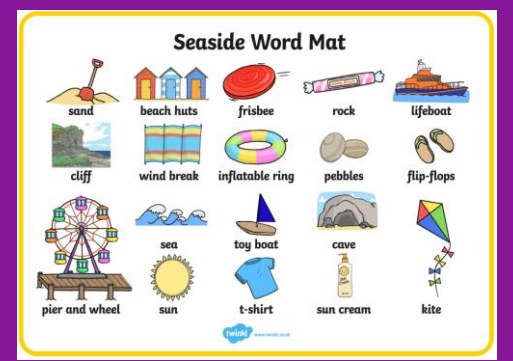
Summer 2

This half term we will be focusing on Seaside Adventures. We will be visiting St Anne's beach and using our sense to investigate the sand. We will be using our imaginations to tell stories.

In our Magic Maths time we will be exploring the numbers to 20 and finding ways to add and subtract 2 numbers. We will be doubling, sharing and looking at odd and even numbers. We will be constructing using shapes and solving problems.



We will continue to explore the woodland area and investigating changes. Looking at mini beasts and trees! We will plant and grow different seeds. We will sing nursery rhymes and learn simple poems. We will paint, make models, create music and use our imagination.

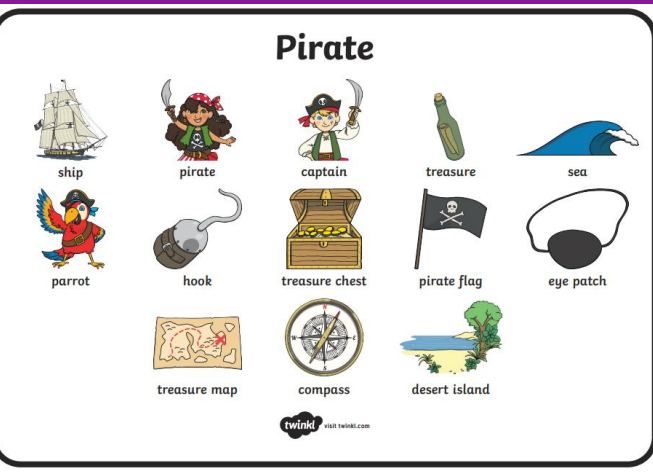


Activities to try
