## History

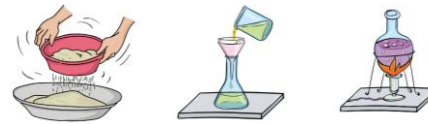
### Crime and Punishment

### Still life

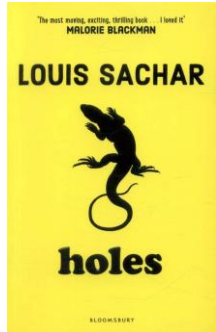

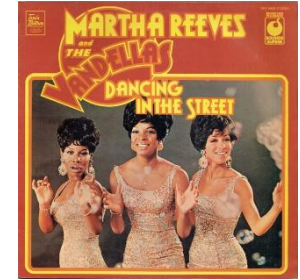

The children will be listening to and learning 'Dancing in the Street' By Martha and the Vandellas



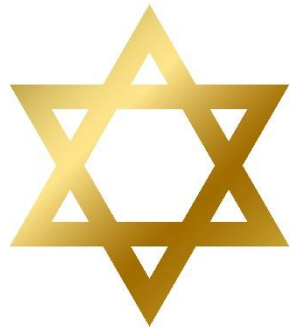
## Computing Programming B
