



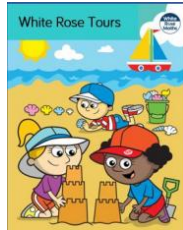
Year 6



Maths

Children will complete projects that have been designed to explore maths in real life contexts, allowing them to see how important maths is in all aspects of life.

They also provide a great opportunity to explore and develop enterprise.



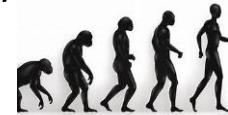
History

Children will learn about how the Vikings invaded Britain. They will research how the Vikings lived and how the longboats were so vital for their success. They will learn about the monastery in Lindisfarne and why it was valuable to the Vikings.

Science

Adaptation and Evolution

Children will learn how living things have changed over time. They will research how animals are adapted to suit their environment in different ways. They will learn that adaptation may lead to evolution.



Art

Children will be investigating features of Viking craftsmanship. They will be looking for the common patterns and motifs that were incorporated into the Vikings jewellery. They will then design and create a piece of jewellery from clay.



English

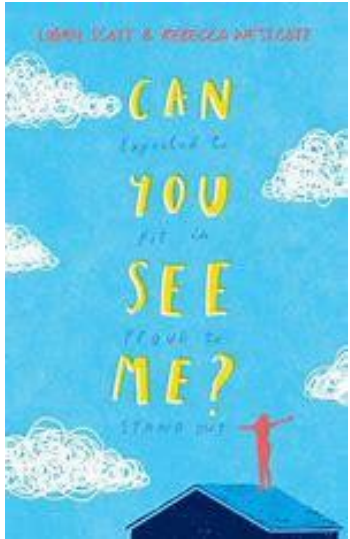
In English, we are reading 'Albert and the Lion' by Marriott Edgar. The poem is a humorous tale that has become a classic in British culture. The children will spend time immersing into the text then performing the poem. They will create a role on the wall for each character-highlighting references in the poem and deducing what tells us about their character.

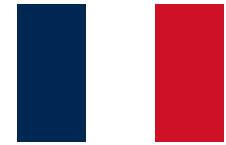
Children will complete units on:
