



Year 6 Trip to Gulliver's World – Important Information

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited for our Year 6 trip to Gulliver's World tomorrow. With the current hot weather conditions, we want to keep all children safe and comfortable, so we have reviewed and amended all our risk assessments for the trip.

What the school will do

- The coach has air conditioning to keep children cool when travelling.
- We will leave the park early (2:00 pm) to avoid the hottest part of the day. We will arrive back at school at 3.05pm.
- There are shaded areas around the theme park, and we have organised an indoor room to rest, cool down and eat lunch.
- Children will take regular scheduled breaks to sit in the shade and drink water.
- Staff will remind children to drink water often and will watch closely for any signs of feeling unwell.
- Take suncream to apply to children if required (with parent consent)
- Take spare sunhats for if children do not have one or loses theirs
- Trained first aiders will be with us at all times.
- All children will wear a wristband with school details for safety.

What you need to do

Please help us by making sure your child:

- Wears light, cool clothing
- Wears comfortable shoes
- Has sun cream applied before school
- Brings sun cream to reapply (if possible)
- Brings a sun hat or cap
- Brings a refillable water bottle. Water will be available at the park, and children can refill their bottles during the day.
