Maths

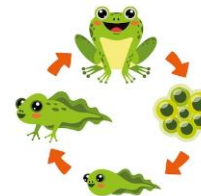

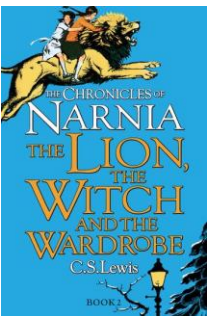
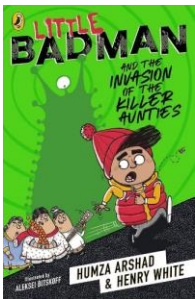
Disney textiles: Children will design, make and evaluate a Disney themed teddy t-shirt.
