Maths

Children will begin with looking at Place Value in 2-digit numbers before moving on to Addition and Subtraction.



History

We will explore the significant places in Burnley and analyse how they have developed over time. We will also look at life in the 19th Century, including schools and toys.



Science

Animals and their Habitats. Children learn about different animals and how they have adapted to suit their habitat. We learn about food sources and food chains and carry out an investigation to find out where woodlice live.

English

In English we read the text: 'Way Home for Wolf'. We write our own stories using talk for writing and invent a new character. Next, we then look at non-fiction texts and write an information page about an animal we have researched.

world was created.



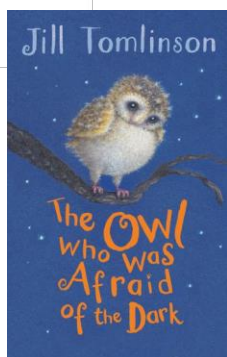
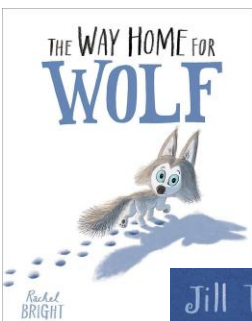
