## Science

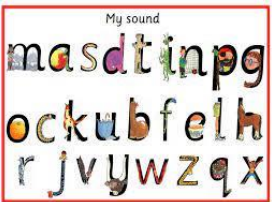
### Life processes - forces

Children will continue learning speedy sounds through multi-sensory lessons at their own pace. Children will also be exploring The Gruffalo to promote a love for reading.

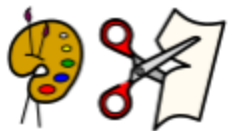

### Make and evaluate

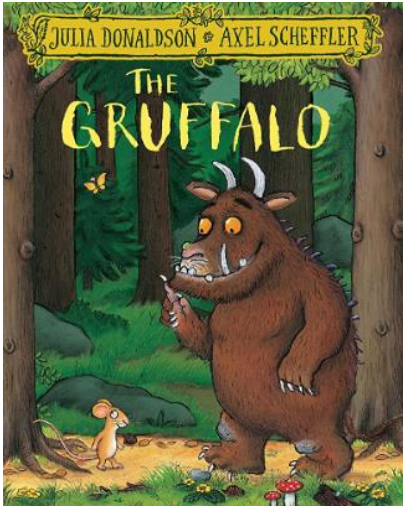
Children will explore a range of different skills such as cutting, sticking, building and painting. This will help them to make their own creations.
