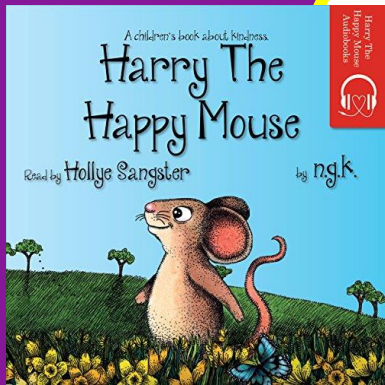
Number Place Value within 10.

English

Children will be focussing on Capital letters, full stops and finger spaces as we write sentences based on our book Harry the Happy Mouse.



Science

Children will learn about five of the groups that scientists use to classify animals: mammals, fish, birds, reptiles and amphibians. They will learn to identify the group an animal belongs to by its features and will classify animals according to their group. They will also learn about the different diets animals eat. Children will learn about the parts of the human body and have the opportunity to explore the five senses through a simple investigation.

Geography

Children will explore the world they live in, starting with an understanding of the United Kingdom and its four countries and the seas that surround it. Children will explore the UK's capital cities and weather patterns. They will have opportunities to observe and record the weather, presenting their own weather forecasts.

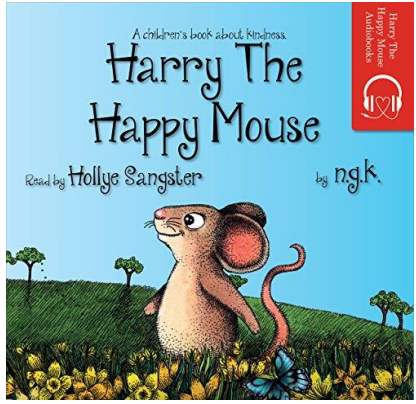
Art
