



# Year 5

## Maths

## Art

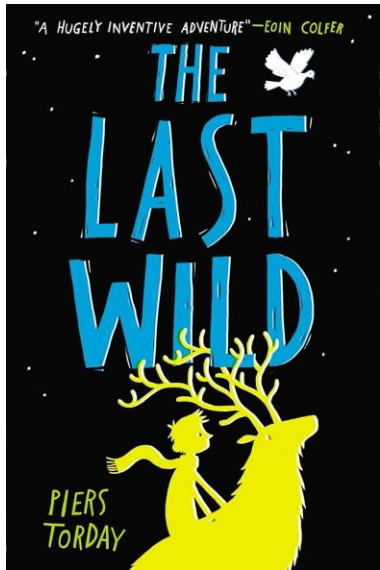
### Local Landscapes
