



Daily RWI Phonics



Magical Mayhem!

We begin this half term with Magic School. The children will become apprentice wizards and use their imagination. Creating potions, magic wands, inventing spells and going to the Magic shop!

We will move on to elves and fairies and other magical creatures and adventures. We will really encourage children to use their imagination and create magical stories and worlds.

We will find out about the festivals of Diwali and Christmas.

We will be continuing our school phonic scheme - Read Write Inc. Children will be split into ability groups. The majority of children should recognise and say at least 16 sounds and are focusing on blending.

We will be teaching children to listen to sounds in words and write them in simple sentences. We will teaching them to have a perfect pencil grip and to form letters correctly. We will encourage children to write their name and read the marks they make.

We will share lots of wonderful stories which will develop speaking and

listening skills and understanding

In our Magic Maths time, we will be exploring numbers to 5 and looking at numbers that are one more or one less. We will be sorting objects, creating pictures with 2D shapes and looking at measurements of time. We will be learning about money in the Magic shop.



We will continue to explore the woodland area and talking about Autumn. We will look at light and dark and about being nocturnal. We will sing nursery rhymes and learn simple poems. We will paint, make music and use our imagination to make up stories and dances.
