In science, the children will be studying the position and function of the different parts of the digestive system. They will also learn how to create and understand food chains.

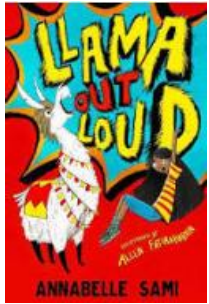


## DT
