### The Jabberwocky

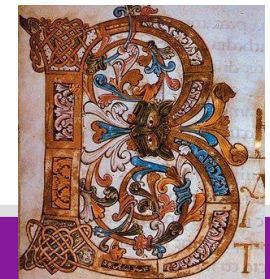

## Art

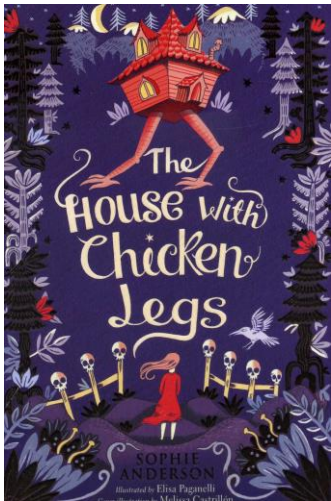
### Anglo-Saxon Manuscripts
