English

Science

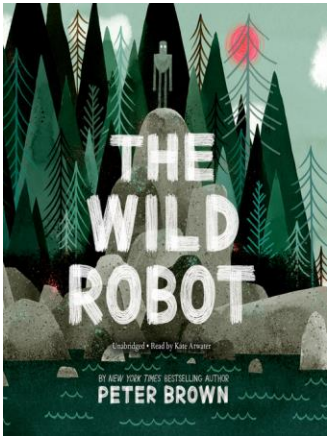
Art
