English

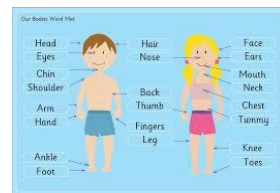
Children are continuing to develop their recognition of speedy sounds and apply Fred Talk to spell out new words. The children follow the scheme at their own pace and will continue reading in class.

Victorian Times

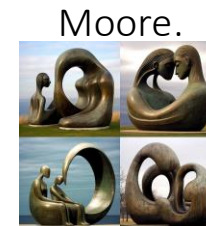
Children will learn about artefacts from Victorian times with a focus on Victorian toys and Victorian dress.

3D

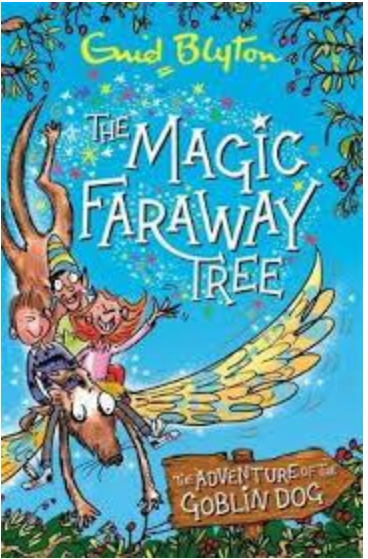
The children will creatively explore a range of materials and techniques using their senses. They will create a 3D sculpture using clay in the style of Henry Moore.
